**Subject: Reporting of Medium Combustion Plants under Decision (EU) 2019/1713
- 2019 (2018) reporting year**

I am writing to you in relation to the reporting obligation under Article 11 of Directive (EU) 2015/2193¹ on Medium Combustion Plants (MCPs). The format of the reporting is set out in Decision (EU) 2019/1713². According to the Directive and the Decision, Member States are required to submit their your reports by **1 January 2021** at the latest.

This report has as its objective the gathering of information on the total annual emissions of CO and any information available on the concentration of emissions of CO from medium combustion plants, grouped by fuel type and capacity class. The obligation is summarised at the EEA's Reporting Obligation Database at <https://rod.eionet.europa.eu/instruments/659>. Please note that this information will need to be submitted only once and preferably for the reporting year 2019. In the absence of data for 2019, data for 2018 may be submitted.


Submission of the information shall take place through Reportnet (<https://cdr.eionet.europa.eu/>), the infrastructure of the European Environment Agency (EEA). In order to facilitate data submission, the EEA has developed an on-line reporting tool (Excel template). You can find it on the corresponding help page in CDR : <https://cdr.eionet.europa.eu/help/mcp>.

In order to submit the report, an EIONET account with user name and password is required. In case a reporter does not have an **EIONET account** yet, he can request it at helpdesk@eionet.europa.eu. We invite countries to inform the EEA (marthe.granger@eea.europa.eu) with the name of the reporter(s) in order to set-up the **access to the national envelope** where the report will be dropped.
