Notification: Opening of the reporting – Mercury Regulation Deadline for reports 31 January 2020

Dear colleagues,

We write to you in relation to the reporting under Regulation (EU) 2017/852, on mercury and its implementing acts. The EEA has assisted the European Commission in putting in place electronic reporting tools to cover the various reporting elements of said pieces of EU-law.

Opening of the reporting and deadline

The reporting tools are now ready in the EEA's reporting platform, the so-called Central Data Repository (CDR) at: https://cdr.eionet.europa.eu/

Reporters must use their own credentials (the so-called Eionet account) that were provided shortly after their nomination by their countries. You can also reset your credentials here: https://www.eionet.europa.eu/password-reset

Please note that the European Commission has recently extended the deadline for reporting to 31 January 2020. Their letter is accessible here.
