

How to deliver boundary data for Ramsar sites through Reportnet

These guidelines explain how to use the Central Data Repository (CDR), which is part of the EEA's Reportnet infrastructure, for reporting information on boundaries of sites designated under the Ramsar Convention. You can contact the [Eionet helpdesk](#) if you need additional assistance.

The reporting is organised in collaboration between the Ramsar Convention Secretariat and the European Environment Agency (EEA).

Step 1: User accounts and access permissions

In order to report in CDR, an Eionet account with user name and password is required as well as permission to upload official national data. Ramsar Convention Secretariat has sent a letter requesting nominations for the person(s) responsible for the reporting, so that the necessary arrangements can be made to provide permissions and passwords.

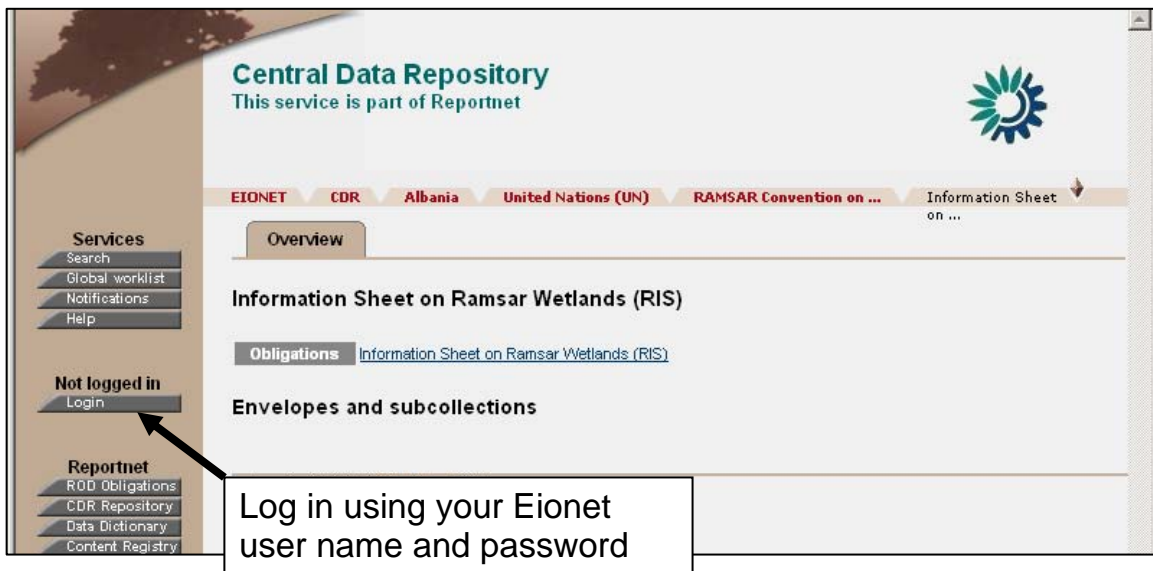
Step 2. Enter the Central Data Repository, login to your folder and create an envelope

When preparing for the boundary data delivery, you first have to go to the Ramsar Information Sheet (RIS) folder for your country in EEA's Central Data Repository (follow the links below).

Log in to the RIS folder using your EIONET user name and password



After logging in, create a new envelope:

New envelope

The envelope is the container for all the files that make up your delivery.

Step 3. Deliver your boundary files

Click on the envelope's name and activate the reporting task. While the task is active, no one except you can use the envelope.

Activate task

You can upload each file separately:

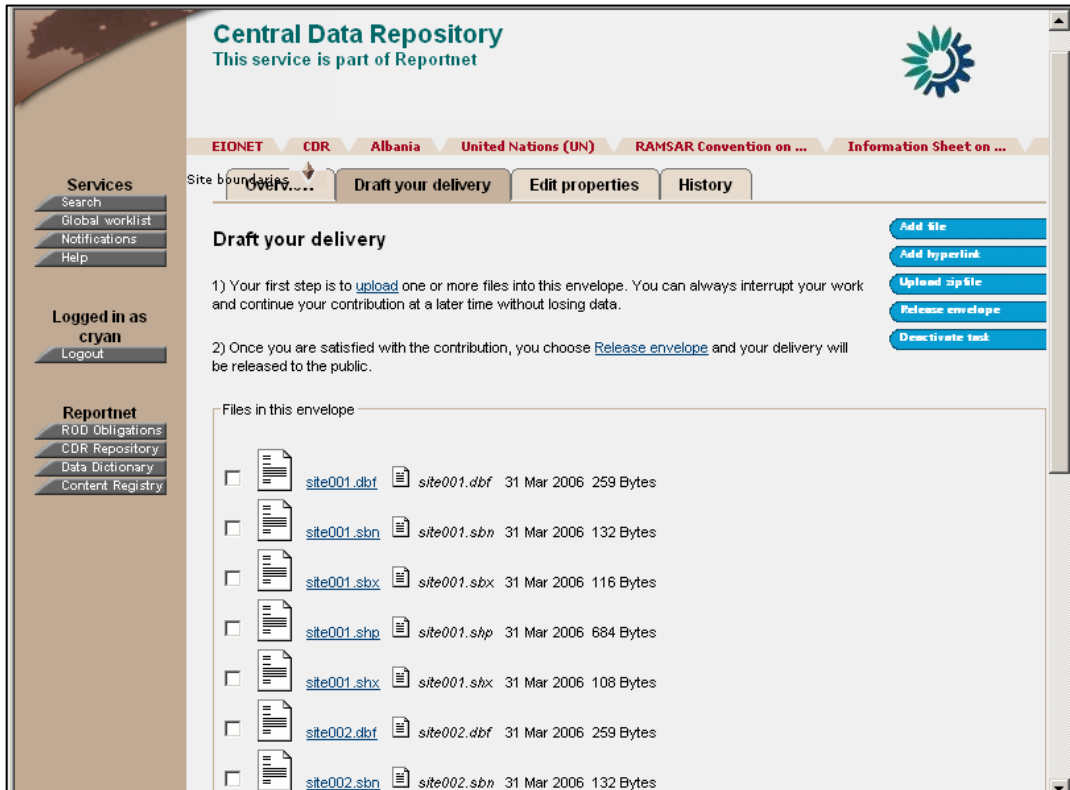
Add file

You can upload a zip file, which will then be unpacked automatically

Add zip file

Step 4. Confirm your delivery

When you are satisfied that your delivery is complete and correct, you should release the envelope. This is your official submission to the Ramsar secretariat.
