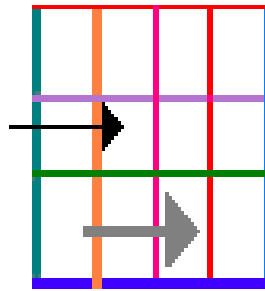

### 1. Introduction

#### 1.1 Purpose

This document accompanies the Version 4.0.16 release of the Greta Emissions Trading Registry.

It describes the changes in the Version 4.0.16 release and the accompanying documentation.

### 2. Version 4.0.16 Release

#### 2.1 Overview

**NOTE:**

After installing Version 4.0.16, before surrenders of allowances or project credits can take place, the CER/ERU parameters must be proposed and subsequently approved from the Work Queue even if there is no change to the method, scope or limits from Version 3.0.84.

**NOTE:**

Version 4.0.16 resolves one high priority bug discovered in 4.0.14 and this document is considered an addendum to the V4.0.14 documentation.

Please read and install Version 4.0.14 before deploying this release. This release can be applied as a 'patch' to Version 4.0.14 by replacing the required dll's and running the upgrade script.

The Greta Version 4.0.16 fixes one high priority bug:

- i. Surrendered transactions in a "proposed" state i.e. in an AAR Work Queue or not yet approved by the ITL did not get counted towards the enforced CER/ERU surrender limit.
