3. Discussion on the list of significant emission sources (to be prepared by both countries prior to the meeting). The list of sources is expected to include:

- Energetic (combustion) sources with over 50 MW (according to the Directive 2001/80/WE)
- Technology sources such as metallurgy (steel works, iron and steel production, sintering, cookery, agglomeration of iron ore), cement works etc.

Information about these sources should include:

- Operational conditions, such as emission limits and other conditions described in pollution enter permits and also in IPPC permits (depending on the type of the plant and national legislation)
- Information about permitting process
- One example of large emission source, that involves permitting process and key information included in the permit
